**NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES OF
SCHOOL DISTRICT OF NEW BERLIN**

The New Berlin School Board has designated the School District Superintendent of Schools, presently Mr. Joe Garza, or in his absence, the Chief Financial/Operations Officer, Mr. Roger Dickson, as the legal custodian of the public records of the Board and of its members, officers and committees.

Each legal custodian is vested by the New Berlin School Board with full legal power to render decisions and carry out the duties of the Board under the Wisconsin public records law. Requests for access to records shall be deferred to the legal custodian. The legal custodian will determine whether a record of the Board must be made available for inspection and/or copying by a requester.

OFFICIAL PUBLIC NOTICE

The School District of New Berlin is a Wisconsin Common School District located in Waukesha County, Wisconsin. It is governed by a School Board composed of seven elected members. Its chief administrative officer is an appointed Superintendent of Schools.

The New Berlin School Board has designated the School District Superintendent of Schools, presently Mr. Joe Garza, or in his absence, the Chief Financial/Operations Officer, Mr. Roger Dickson, as the legal custodian of the public records of the Board and of its members, officers and committees.

The Public may obtain information about disclosure of public records, make requests for such disclosure and, in accordance with applicable law, inspect or obtain copies of such records in the custody of the Board at the following place and times:

In addition, copies may be requested and, as appropriate, obtained by mail.

The New Berlin School Board is authorized by law to impose a fee on the requester which does not exceed the actual, necessary and direct cost of reproduction and transcription of the record, unless some other fee is otherwise specifically established by law or charged by the School Board. Per Board Administrative Rule 1340, a requester shall be charged a fee for the cost of copying and locating records as follows:

1. The fee for photocopying shall be ten cents (\$.10) for each side of a page; such cost and all future costs shall not exceed the actual, necessary and direct costs of reproduction.
2. If the form of a written record does not permit copying, the actual and necessary cost of photographing and photographic processing shall be charged.
3. The actual full cost of providing a copy of other records not in printed form on paper, such as films, computer printouts and audio or video tapes, shall be charged.
4. If mailing or shipping is necessary, the actual cost thereof shall also be charged.
5. There shall be no charge for locating a record unless the actual cost therefore exceeds \$50, in which case the entire actual cost shall be imposed upon the requester.
6. The legal custodian shall estimate the cost of all applicable fees and may require a cash deposit adequate to assure payment, if such estimate exceeds \$5.
7. Elected officials and employees of the school district shall not be required to pay for public records they may reasonably require for the proper performance of their official duties.
8. The legal custodian may provide copies of a record without charge or at a reduced charge where he/she determines that waiver or reduction of the fee is in the public interest.
