The School District of New Berlin believes that the family plays a crucial role in students' human growth and development education. The schools support both parents/guardians and children in their efforts to develop an understanding of personal safety, puberty, human sexuality, and the family. Because of this, we will have a human growth and development lesson each year, K-6. These lessons will be delivered by your classroom teacher with the exception of 5th grade. If you are a 5th grade parent, you will be getting a separate letter detailing the instruction and opt out procedures.

Kindergarten	Who is a stranger? What are ways I can say no?
1 st Grade	How do I respond to a touch that is unwanted? Who are trusted adults?
2 nd Grade	How do I describe steps to good hygiene?
3 rd Grade	What secrets are not okay to keep? What do I do if there is something I need to share with a parent or teacher? There is a sensitive book read during this lesson.
4 th Grade	What is puberty? What hygiene needs come from puberty?
5 th Grade	What changes occur to my body during puberty? Boys and girls are separated for this lesson.
6 th Grade	How can I respond to emotionally-charged situations? What happens to my brain when I am highly emotional?
