

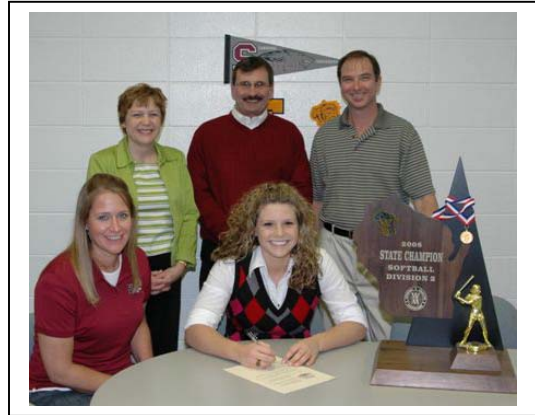


Schlegel picks Cardinal Stritch

Returning State Champion New Berlin Eisenhower Lion's star pitcher, Kayla Schlegel, plans to continue her softball career at Cardinal Stritch University.

Schlegel, who pitched 74 innings last year with 130 strike outs, has accepted a scholarship to Cardinal Stritch University. Stritch is part of the National Association for Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA). The Wolves compete against some of the tougher small college programs throughout the Midwest, which provides for exciting and competitive schedules.

"Kayla plays at a high level because she has put in so much effort to become the best softball player that she could be. She is a true team player who puts the goals of the group ahead of her individual goals," said Coach Setz. Last year, Schlegel has a 0.662 ERA, had 7 earned runs and a record of 12-0. She did not allow a hit greater than a double and her batting average was .369, a slugging percentage of .569, had 4 doubles, 3 triples and a home run.

Senior Kayla Schlegel joins teammate and pitcher Lauren Beres who signed with UW Green Bay earlier this year. Kayla will play a major role in the Lions attempt to repeat as State Champions this spring. Congratulations Kayla.
