



Dear Parents/Guardian,

We have several students in our New Berlin Schools who have **severe** allergies to peanuts and/or tree nuts (walnuts, pecans, almonds, pistachios, etc). Strict avoidance of peanut/tree nut products is the only way to prevent a life threatening allergic reaction. Allergic reactions can occur if the peanut/tree nut is ingested or touched and in some children, inhaled. Each year the number of students with nut allergies increases. We are asking parents to refrain from sending any products that may have peanuts, nuts, or peanut oil as an ingredient to school for lunch, an individual snack, a “group snack”, or “birthday treat”. We would also request that on those occasions parents consider sending healthy snacks.

We are asking your assistance in providing our students with a safe learning environment. We appreciate your support in this matter and your cooperation in helping keep our students safe. If you have any questions, please contact me, or the principal at the school your child attends.
