New Berlin Eisenhower Named #1 WI High School by U.S. News & World Report

For College Readiness, Eisenhower ranks #2 and New Berlin West ranks #6 in WI

New Berlin, Wis. – New Berlin Eisenhower is the top high school in Wisconsin, according to <u>U.S. News &</u> <u>World Report's 2015 Best High Schools</u> list released today.

In College Readiness, Eisenhower ranked #2 and New Berlin West High School ranked #6 in Wisconsin, due to their respective high Advanced Placement participation rates and test scores.

"We are gratified by these results and believe they validate the substantial efforts the School District of New Berlin is making to ensure every graduate is prepared for college and career," said Joe Garza, Superintendent.

New Berlin Eisenhower Middle/High School was one of two high schools in Wisconsin to receive a national gold medal from *U.S. News & World Report.* The other high school was Middleton High School in Dane County.



As explained by US News & World Report, there are several steps that a school must "pass" in order to receive a gold, silver or bronze medal. New Berlin's other high school, West, was not ranked for a medal as a result of discrepancies between economically disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged students.

"Both our high schools are excellent and frequently receive state, regional and national accolades," Garza said, noting that each list published has different criteria and data sources. The District considers multiple data sources in its continuous improvement planning process. "We are always looking at ways we can improve in order to deliver the excellence that the New Berlin community expects and that our students deserve."

College Readiness

A College Readiness index ranking was based on schools' Advanced Placement (AP[©]) participation rates and test results (AP[©] scores of 3 or higher).

At New Berlin West, 69% of students took AP exams, with 65% receiving a score of 3 or higher. At New Berlin Eisenhower, 72% of students took AP exams, with 80% receiving a score of 3 or higher. Data was based on 12th grade students in the 2012-13 school year.

"We are very proud of AP program because it offers our students opportunities to take rigorous, relevant coursework that aligns to their interests and goals," said Garza. AP is one of many indicators the District uses to assess if students are college ready.
