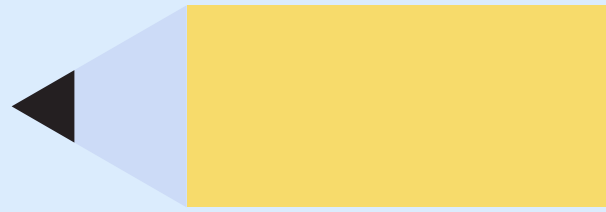

- Hold a valid and current Wisconsin Teaching License
- OR -
- Obtain a Substitute Permit from the State Department of Public Instruction with completion of an Associate's or Bachelor's degree and a Edustaff Short Term Substitute Training Program
- Complete a Conduct and Competency Review Form
- Complete and submit a negative TB test or TB Risk Assessment Form

PARAPROFESSIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- Have a high school diploma
- Complete and submit a negative TB test or TB Risk Assessment Form
- For a SPED Aide
 - Must have a high school diploma AND obtain the WI SPED Aide License.
