SDNB, Waukesha State Bank Ink 5-Year Athletics Sponsorship Agreement, Includes Naming Rights of Eisenhower Concession Stand

New Berlin, Wis. – The School District of New Berlin has entered a 5-year, \$35,000 agreement with Waukesha State Bank that designates the bank as an official sponsor of both the New Berlin Eisenhower and West high school athletics programs, and gives the bank naming rights to Eisenhower's indoor concession stand.

Waukesha State Bank will have signage at Eisenhower's concession stand and in the Drexel Fieldhouse at West recognizing the sponsorship and the bank's support of the athletics programs.

"We are incredibly grateful for Waukesha State Bank's desire to partner with us and for their financial commitment to our district," SDNB Superintendent Joe Garza said. "We are excited to have their support and we are looking forward to finding ways to build a stronger relationship to benefit our students, staff and schools."

Waukesha State Bank was founded in 1944. It now has 14 branch locations throughout Waukesha County, including its New Berlin location, 14000 W. National Ave., which opened in 2013. The bank's mission statement highlights a commitment to serve the community, provide for its employees and reward its stockholders.

This is the fourth naming rights sponsorship signed by the SDNB during the current 2021-22 school year. Previously agreed to partnerships were with Drexel Building Supply (West's fieldhouse), Aspen Orthopedic Specialists and Orthopaedic Hospital of Wisconsin (West's outdoor baseball and soccer complex); and Optimum Crush (West's softball field).
