2011 WIAA Division 2 State Champions – Girls Swimming and Diving

The School District of New Berlin is proud to recognize the state-championship performances of two members of the New Berlin West and Eisenhower Middle/High School's girls swimming teams at the WIAA 2011 Division 2 Girls Swimming and Diving State Meet held November 11, 2011.

Tew For Two

New Berlin West freshman swimmer Madison Tew competed in two individual events: the 200-yard freestyle and 500-yard freestyle. Striking gold in both events, her 1:52.42 time in the 200 ranks her eighth in Division 2 all-time state performances and sets a new school record. Her time of 5:02.95 in the 500 also breaks the longest-standing school record.



Belford Repeats as State Champ

Eisenhower senior, Alli Belford, finished her high school swimming career by placing first and second at the meet, winning the 50-yard freestyle for the second straight year. Her time of 23.43 broke the Eisenhower record and narrowly missed the Wisconsin state record. Alli was also the runner up in the 100-yard freestyle with a school-record time of 52.37. Her individual and relay performances (3rd and 6th in the freestyle relays) contributed to Ike's 5th-place team finish at this year's meet, the highest the team has finished in decades. Alli will swim at Michigan's Oakland University next year.
