

## NAMING OF SCHOOLS, FACILITIES AND PROPERTIES

It is the responsibility of the Board to name school district buildings, facilities and properties. The Superintendent shall develop administrative procedures to assist the School Board.

Criteria to be considered when naming school facilities shall be the following:

- A. A facility may be named after a geographic location, characteristics and/or a section of the district it serves.
- B. If a facility is to be named after a person, that person shall be of exemplary moral character, and
  - 1. have made an outstanding contribution to education, humanity or community; or
  - 2. have displayed outstanding prominence locally or nationally in the fields of education, science, art, statesmanship, political science or the military; or
  - 3. be a person of historical significance.

Parts of facilities named after individuals shall use the same criteria for recognition of individuals and may be marked by an appropriate plaque commemorating that individual's contribution.
