

SCHOOL FOOD SERVICE

The School District of New Berlin shall annually determine which schools, if any, will participate in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), a federally assisted meal program. The district shall provide nutritious and well-balanced lunches to children in participating schools in accordance with the provisions outlined in the NSLP.

Payment for meals shall be made in advance of being served to pupils. In schools that participate in the NSLP, an alternative lunch, meeting the guidelines of the NSLP as a reimbursable meal, will be provided to elementary pupils whose account balance is insufficient to cover the cost of the meal, such cost to be charged to the pupil's account. Secondary pupils will be allowed a negative balance up to, but not greater than, the value of one school meal, such value to be determined annually by the Director of School Nutrition Services in conformance with NSLP regulations.

Families will be advised, through established communication channels, when a student's account balance falls below \$10.00. If a student's negative account balance is \$25.00 or greater the family will receive notification by mail through the United States Postal Service that payment is due within 10 days to avoid collection. Amounts unpaid after 10 days may be submitted for collection in accordance with established procedure.

District will communicate this policy to all households at the start of each school year and to the household of any student that transfers into the district during the school year through publication in student handbooks at the secondary level and the weekly packet for elementary schools.

The School District of New Berlin pursuant to s.118.13, Wisconsin Statutes, and PI 9, does not discriminate against pupils on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, ancestry, color, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability or handicap in its education programs, activities or operations.
