

SCHOLARSHIP PROCEDURES

The School District of New Berlin will not deny any person admission to, participation in, or the benefits of any curricular, extracurricular, pupil services, recreational or other program or activity because of a person's gender, race, color, national origin, religion, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability.

Where there are ties for scholarships where the determination of scholarship recipients is based upon the GPA, the high school scholarship selection committee will select the student to be awarded the scholarship in question, and will rank as well those who were tied but not designated as winners of the scholarship.

In ranked order, the following criteria will be utilized:

1. Total number of Advanced Placement courses and/or other collegiate level courses that are approved by the school district;
2. Total number of credits earned and recorded on school record (transcript);
3. Number of semester honors courses taken for credit;
4. Best ACT composite score based on ACT tests already taken.
