

VANDALISM

A primary task of the school is to create a stimulating climate which develops active involvement of students in their education and self responsibility. This climate is created when students work together with school staff in such activities as planning and implementing vandalism prevention programs.

The School District of New Berlin believes that students should be responsible for damage to school district property caused by improper or inappropriate conduct. Therefore, the District will pursue reimbursement from students and, where appropriate, parents, for damage to District property and equipment caused by the willful and/or reckless conduct of students.

Principals are hereby granted the authority to assess reasonable and just restitution, including material, labor and administrative costs, for damage to school books and property. Parents of minor students will be contacted by District officials as soon as possible after school official are aware that damage has occurred.

Principals may, at their discretion, require vandals to appear for a pre-expulsion hearing.

A reward of up to one hundred dollars (\$100.00) may be given to any citizen (including a student) who gives information which leads to the conviction of any persons guilty of theft, burglary or vandalism of school property.
