

ADVANCED PLACEMENT

Every Advanced Placement course offered by the School District of New Berlin will follow and maintain the rigor and standards of the national Advanced Placement Curriculum.

In order to facilitate and ensure implementation of this policy, the following procedures will be put in place:

- a. gather statistics from the College Board comparing district scores to state scores to national scores in order to determine whether New Berlin students meet or exceed the state and national statistics;
- b. survey AP students for their grades in their college freshman-level courses;
- c. interview AP students in order to gain their perceptions on their preparation for the exam based on specific questions about content;
- d. expect that AP students take the AP exam for the course(s) in which they are enrolled;
- e. ensure that the district pay the cost of the exam for students who show financial need;
