

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT

It is the policy of the New Berlin Board of Education to promote school improvement through the monitoring and evaluation of student learning on a school-by-school basis.

The Superintendent of Schools shall be responsible for establishing an accountability system to promote school improvement which enhances school results. The accountability system shall establish specific school-by-school objectives which measure student learning and other school results. The Superintendent shall report on a yearly basis to the Board of Education the improvement progress made by each school. At the same time schools should be given latitude in teaching methodologies and the use of instructional materials. Learning activities and instructional materials should conform to "prevailing community values", as determined by the Board.
