

FILLING VACANCY ON THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

When a vacancy occurs caused by the events in accordance with Wisconsin Statute 17.03, the remaining members of the Board of Education shall:

DEADLINE

1. Fill the vacancy by an appointment in all cases except where the lack of time remaining between the occurrence of the vacancy and the election of a successor makes it impractical to complete the appointment process.

NOTIFICATION

1. Inform the media that a vacancy has occurred and that applications are being received.
2. Inform the public via posting in each school that a vacancy has occurred and that applications are being received.

CONSIDERATION

1. Give consideration to interested citizens who submit a written application and who appear for a personal interview before the Board of Education.

SELECTION

1. The Board of Education shall appoint, by a majority vote, the person considered by the Board to be the best qualified to fill the vacancy. (Wis. Stat 17.26.)
2. The Board President shall appoint the member if the Board of Education is unable to appoint a candidate within 60 days of the date on which the vacancy occurs.
