School District of New Berlin to Showcase, Recognize Arts Program at First-Ever Student Art Gallery Night on Nov. 14

New Berlin, Wis. –The School District of New Berlin will showcase more than 70 pieces of student artwork at its first-ever Student Art Gallery Night to be held from 5-6:30 p.m. Monday, Nov. 14, in District Office, 4333 S. Sunnyslope Rd.

Students from across the district will have their art on display for friends, family members, school staff, district personnel and School Board members in various hallways and conference rooms throughout District Office. The artwork will remain on display through the school year.

Several pieces of art will be available through a silent auction with proceeds going to the district's arts program through the New Berlin Education Foundation, Inc. The initial bid for available pieces will be \$25. Additionally, guests will be entertained by a student string quartet.
