School and Community

New Berlin Eisenhower (IKE) is a college preparatory high school and one of two high schools in the New Berlin community. IKE serves approximately 716 students in an upper-middle class community with an involved parent support group interested in academic, social and community success for their children who attend school.

- Guidance from counselors and other staff to develop and support the student's Academic and Career Plan.

- Service learning and other offerings for students encouraging civic responsibility and personal integrity.
- School structure allows for middle school students to take high school coursework within their building and schedule.

- On-site Certified Nursing Assistant program.
- We offer 24 different sports and 44 clubs/activities. Eighty percent of our students are involved in a co-curricular activity, sport or club.
