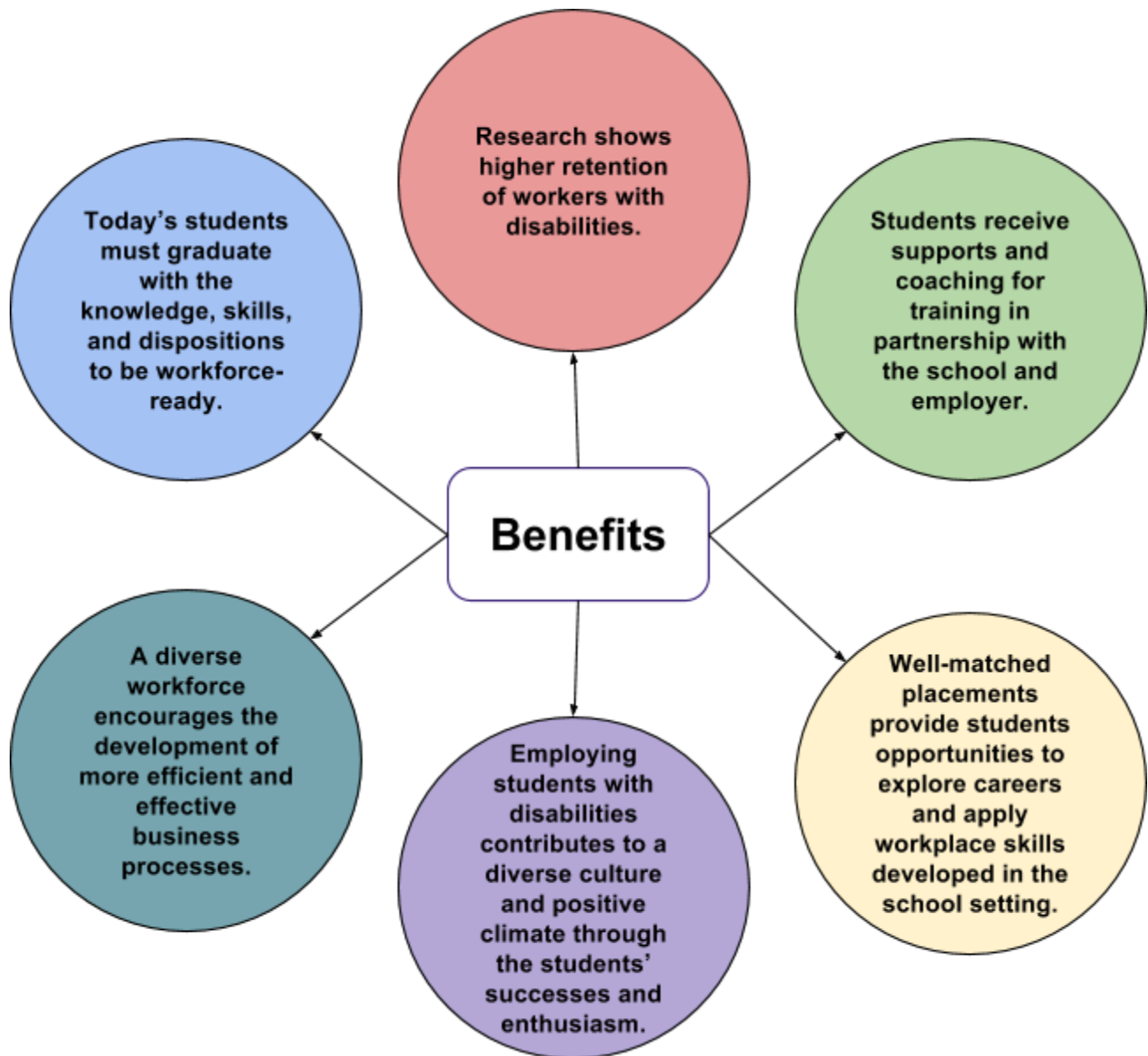

Foundations Program

- Grades 7-12
- Based at New Berlin Eisenhower & New Berlin West

- Most students are learning skills to be employed.
- SDNB staff provide job development and coaching.

Pathways Program

- Post Grade 12
- Students are 18-21 years old.
- Based out of a local apartment.
- Program focuses on the students' transition to post-secondary.
- Emphasizes on independence and employability.
- Most students are employed.
- SDNB staff provides job development.
- DVR and/or SDNB staff provide job coaching.
