General

Headphones/earbuds will be required for FastBridge testing for 9th grade students and may be needed at times in other classes.

Art

Digital Art Design: A digital camera is strongly suggested.

Digital Art Photography: Flash drive, digital camera (minimum 8 megapixel with memory card).

AP Art History, AP Studio Art I & II 2-D Design: flash drive (1 GB or larger).

Business & Marketing

Students will need a folder or binder, notebook and writing utensil.

Computer Science

Exploring Computer Science, Cybersecurity, Web Development I and II: Students will need a folder or binder, notebook and writing utensil.

AP Computer Science A, Computer Programming, Game Design, AP Computer Science Principles: USB Flash drive, folder or binder, notebook and writing utensil.

Data Structures: USB Flash drive, Graphing calculator (TI-83, TI-83 plus, TI-84, TI-84 plus or TI-84 plus C, folder or binder, notebook and writing utensil.

English

On a daily basis, students will need writing utensils and dedicated supplies for taking notes and organizing handouts.

Engineering & Technology

All Project Lead the Way students will need writing utensils, folder, notebook, flash drive and calculator.

Construction I, II & III: Writing utensils, folder, notebook, flash drive and calculator.

Graphic Production I, II: Writing utensils, folder, and headphones.

Graphic Production III: Writing utensils and folder.

Health Occupations

Medical Terminology: Consumable book (\$115) may be purchased in the bookstore.

Certified Nursing Assistant WCTC: Lab and Clinical Days require cobalt blue scrub top and pants, white shoes, gait belt, purchase at the WCTC bookstore. White tennis shoes and a watch with a second hand and flexible watchband is required for class and clinical.

Math

Algebra 1: Graphing calculator (TI-83, TI 83plus, TI-84, TI-84plus, or TI-84plus C), graph paper, loose leaf paper, ruler.

Algebra 2: Graphing calculator (TI-83, TI 83plus, TI-84, TI-84plus, or TI-84plus C), binder with tabs, graph paper, pencils, colored pencils, markers, ruler, scissors, red pen.

Geometry: Graphing calculator(TI-83, TI 83plus, TI-84, TI-84plus, or TI-84plus C), ruler, protractor, compass, graph paper, tracing paper, scissors, colored pencils/pens, 3 x 5 notecards.

Functions & Trigonometry: Binder, loose leaf paper and/ or notebook, graph paper, graphing calculator (TI-83, TI 83plus, TI-84, TI-84plus, or TI-84plus C).

Pre-Calculus & Statistics: Graphing calculator (TI-83, TI 83plus, TI-84, TI-84plus, or TI-84plus C).

Statistics, AP Statistics, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus BC: Graphing calculator (TI-83, TI 83plus, TI-84, TI-84plus, or TI-84plus C).

Music

Concert Choir: Students must supply black dress shoes.

Concert Orchestra: *Essential Technique 2000* (book 3), binder, instrument.

Jazz Ensemble: Instrument

Symphonic/Marching Band: Instrument, Uniform expectations are set by the band directors

Treble Choir: Black dress shoes for performances. Robes and stoles are provided at West.

Chamber Singers: Pocket folder and pencil. Black dress shoes for performances.

A Cappella Choir: Black dress shoes for performances; students wearing tuxes will provide white tux shirt. Concert dresses and tuxes provided for members of the ensemble.

Chamber Orchestra: *Essential Elements Advanced Technique* (book 4), binder, instrument.

Music Appreciation and AP Music Theory: Pencils, binder, spiral notebook, "Finale Notepad" (free download from home), flash drive.

Physical Education

Appropriate athletic footwear, change of appropriate athletic clothing, school-issued combination lock.

Science

Biology and Honors: Binder and folder/ composition books (1 per quarter), pens, pencils, colored pencils.

AP Environmental Science: Folder and notebook or 3-ring binder with loose-leaf paper and writing utensils.

AP Physics I & II & C Mechanics: Scientific calculator (graphing allowed), lab notebook-bound (quad-ruled composition notebook).

Environmental Science: Writing utensil, notebook, folders/binder.

Earth Science: Folder/notebook or 3-ring binder/loose-leaf paper, writing utensils.
