

Derby Rules:

- Pitchers will be provided to all batters, or you may bring your own pitcher.
- Both girls and boys will use baseballs.
- All players must wear a batting helmet.
- Each participant gets eight (8) outs. Each ball hit that is not a Home Run is counted as an out.
 Any pitch that is swung upon and missed, fouled, or not hit over the fence is counted as an out.
- Balls that are batted over the fence in fair territory are considered Home Runs and will not be counted toward the total outs.
- Tie breaker: Each player gets 3 additional outs.
- Trophies will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place.



Ages 6 & Under Distance 75 FT. to Fence
Ages 7, 8 Distance 100 FT. to Fence
Ages 9, 10 Distance 125 FT. to Fence
Ages 11, 12 Distance 150 FT. to Fence
Ages 13, 14 Distance 200 FT. to Fence
Ages 15 to Adult Distance 250 FT. to Fence

Players should enter the age group based on their age on May 11, 2024.
