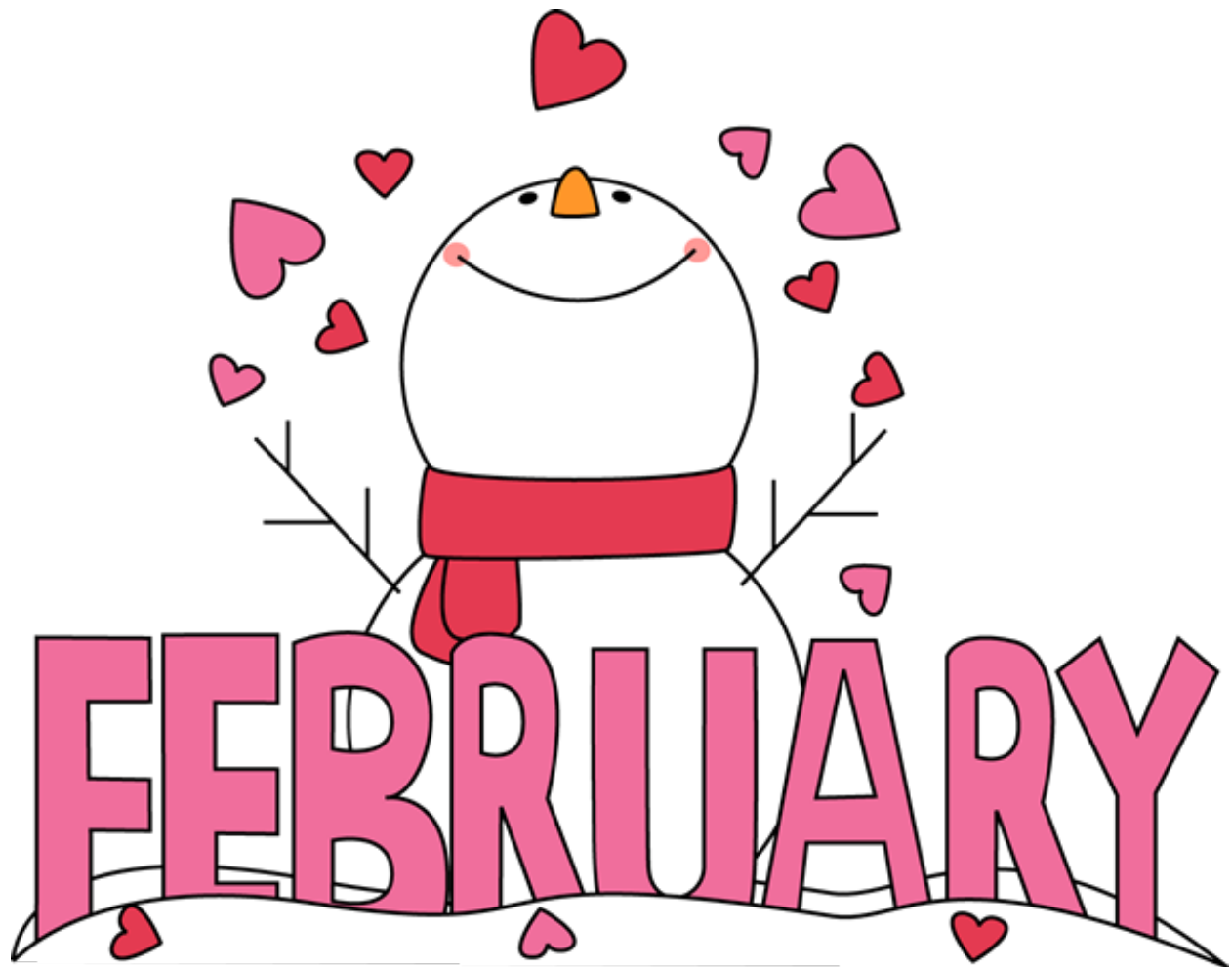

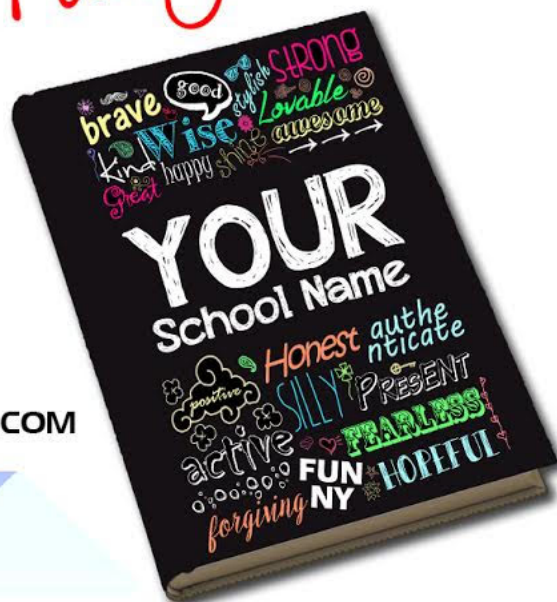

Meeting Purpose / Goals / Objectives:

This meeting is designed for parents with children **currently in grades 4 - 7** (New Berlin WEST residency) with interest in learning more about youth tackle football for the New Berlin West Youth Football Club (NBWYFC).

NBWYFC President and guest speakers will provide an introduction to youth tackle football and share perspective from their years participating in the NBWYFC and the All-American Youth Football League (AAYFL). The meeting format will ensure ample time for all participants to ask questions and learn how the game of football has evolved over the past several years with heightened safety precautions & practices. The objective of this meeting is not to persuade parents to sign their children up for tackle football. The objective is to introduce families to the sport of youth football, how the game is currently played and managed, discuss pros and cons, and address any and all questions/concerns from those in attendance.

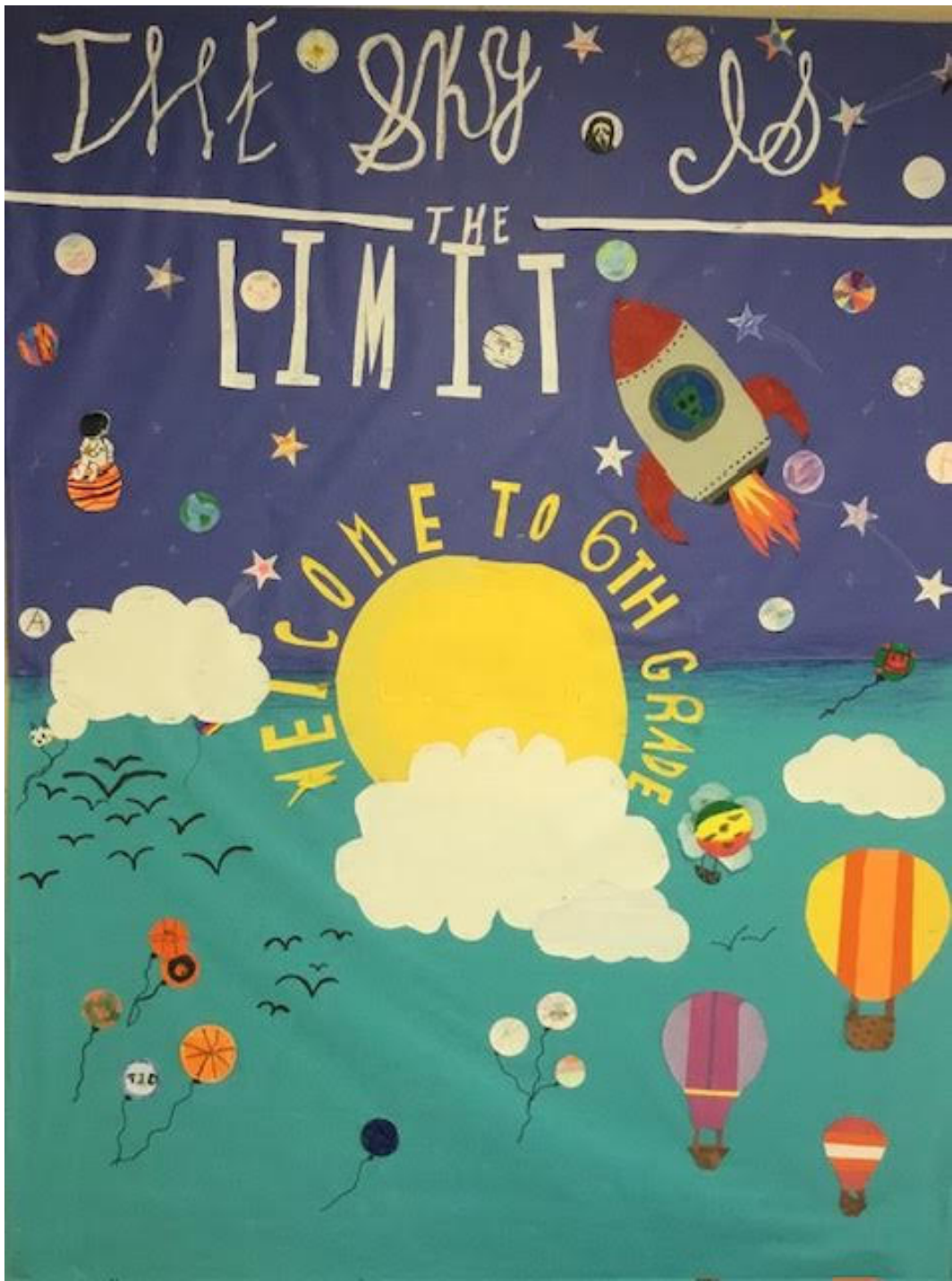
