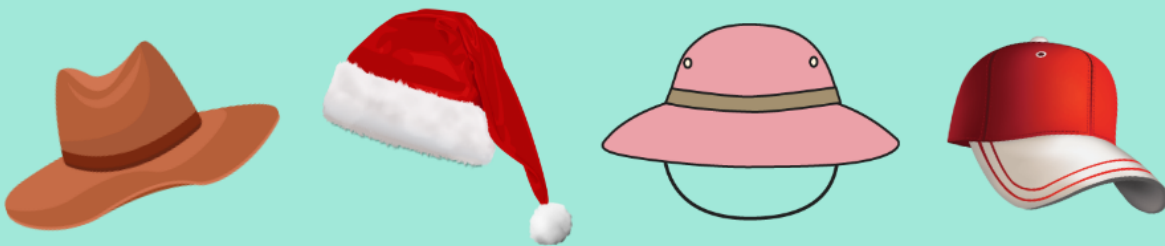

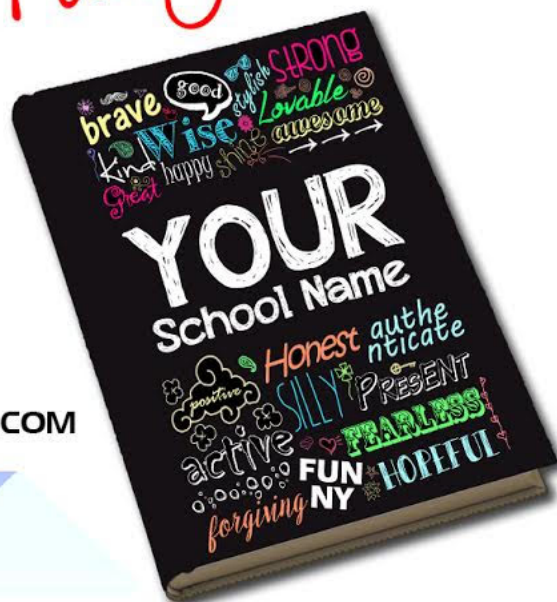

This 8-week session at Poplar Creek runs Thursdays, 3:50-4:50 pm, April 11-May 30.

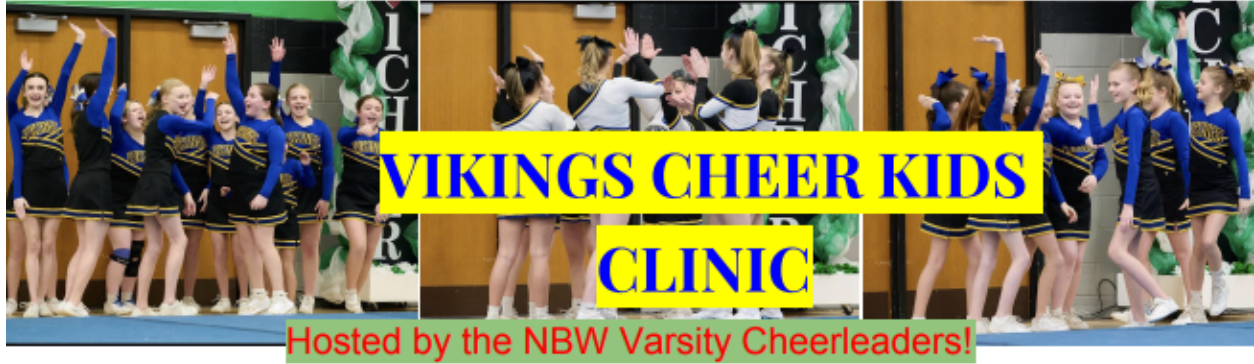
Students will explore many of the zany characters from Bikini Bottom while singing and dancing to songs from this Broadway hit!

Meeting Purpose / Goals / Objectives:

This meeting is designed for parents with children **currently in grades 4 - 7** (New Berlin WEST residency) with interest in learning more about youth tackle football for the New Berlin West Youth Football Club (NBWYFC).

NBWYFC President and guest speakers will provide an introduction to youth tackle football and share perspective from their years participating in the NBWYFC and the All-American Youth Football League (AAYFL). The meeting format will ensure ample time for all participants to ask questions and learn how the game of football has evolved over the past several years with heightened safety precautions & practices. The objective of this meeting is not to persuade parents to sign their children up for tackle football. 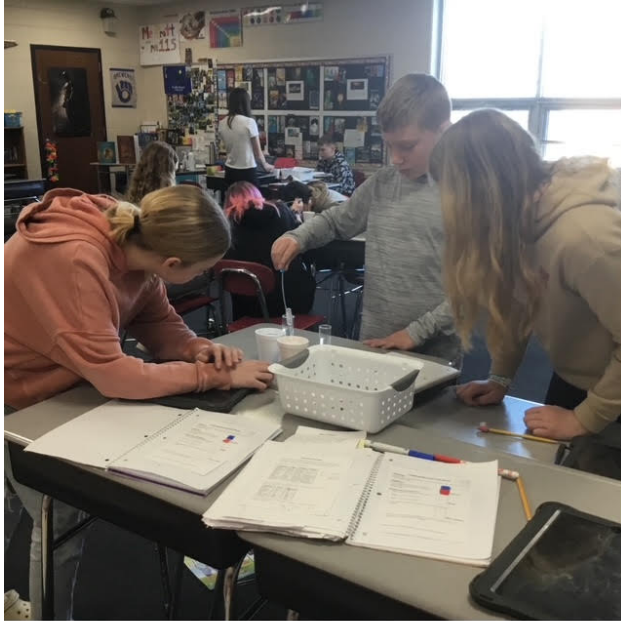

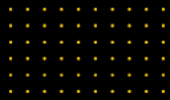
