From the Desk of Mr. S

Good afternoon Poplar Creek Families,

Earlier this week, the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction released district and school report card information for all 378 school districts and thousands of schools across the state.

We are happy to share with you that we received a 90.4, which means our school SIGNIFICANTLY EXCEEDS EXPECTATIONS, as defined by the state. What's more, the School District of New Berlin was one of just nine K-12 districts in Wisconsin to significantly exceed expectations.

District and school report cards are intended to offer accountability of how well schools and districts statewide are preparing students to graduate. Report cards provide an accountability index score from 0-100 based on performance in four priority areas:

- Student achievement, or how well the students performed on state assessments using a pointsbased proficiency system with the score a result of a multi-year average of English language arts and mathematics subscores;
- Growth, or year-to-year student progress on statewide tests;
- Target Group Outcomes, which examines outcomes for students with the lowest test scores and is designed to promote equity by helping districts focus on learners who need the most support while also improving outcomes for all students;
- On-track to graduation, or how successfully students are progressing toward completing their K-12 education.

While we are incredibly proud of our score and the distinction that it carries, we are also anxious and excited to dive deeper into the information and find areas where we can improve.
