Part time Kitchen Help Needed! No experience necessary!

New Berlin West and Eisenhower have openings for kitchen help. Job duties include light cooking, cashiering, serving students during meal service, and clean-up. Kitchen help will work a job rotation schedule for the various positions in the kitchen with one early and one late start in the rotation. Most rotations work 4 hours per day from approximately 9 a.m. - 1 p.m. One rotation may start earlier if needed and one rotation starts later and ends about 3:15 p.m. Starting wage is \$16.25/hour.

Substitute Staff Needed. Duties include, assisting cooks with food inventory and preparation, helping serve students during meal service, entering charges into lunch accounts, and cleaning the cafeteria/kitchen. Hours and locations depend on your availability and staffing needs. Starting wage is \$15/hour. These are non-benefit positions that work a school year calendar. No experience is needed.
